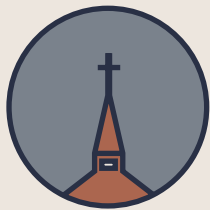

**What do we mean when we call the Scriptures the Word of God?**

The Scriptures manifest themselves to be the Word of God, by their majesty and purity; by the consent of all the parts, and the scope of the whole, which is to give all glory to God; by their light and power to convince and convert sinners, to comfort and build up believers unto salvation: but the Spirit of God bearing witness by and with the Scriptures in the heart of people, is alone able fully to persuade us they are the very Word of God.

**What do the Scriptures principally teach?**

The Scriptures principally teach what we are to believe concerning God, and what God requires of us.

**What do the Scriptures make known of God?**

The Scriptures make known: Who God is, what God has done, how God calls us to live, and how we can fulfill God's calling in the world.
