"Disputable Matters and Godly Lives"

- How can we distinguish a kingdom essential from a disputable matter when both feel deeply important to us?
- Where do concerns about control or change tend to hide beneath seemingly minor disagreements in a church community?
- Paul tells believers not to damage another person's faith simply to be right. What might this principle require of us in a real disagreement?
- How does remembering that none of us lives only for ourselves reshape the way we express strong convictions?
- What is the difference between offering an opinion respectfully and allowing that opinion to become a dividing line?
- The sermon asks, "How much would this matter to Jesus?" How could that question change our priorities, speech, or decisions?
- Which practices—love, grace, prayer, community, or sharing the gospel—most help a church keep Christ's kingdom at the center, and why?
